FALL 2021 FRANCIS RHODES MONTGOMERY DESIGN COMPETITION RESULTS

The Fall 2021 ASME Hawaii Francis Rhodes Montgomery Design Competition (FRMDC) was held on Friday, December 10, 2021 via Zoom video conference. The annual event is in its 34th year and is cosponsored by the University of Hawaii at Manoa, Department of Mechanical Engineering, and the ASME Hawaii Francis R. Montgomery Foundation.

This Fall, under the guidance of Dr. Zachery Trimble, the design competition consisted of 4 project teams from the ME 481/482 design course. Teams performed a timed presentation detailing their project goals, challenges, application of engineering principles, and design results. The teams also were able to host timed poster presentations where judges were able to ask more detailed questions about each project. The teams utilized pre-recorded videos to demonstrate their projects. Due to the complexity and size of these projects, the videos were significant to demonstrate each of the projects functionality and successes.

Student projects included the University of Hawaii Drone Technologies (UHDT), an unmanned surface vessel for Autonomous Marine Robotics Research (Kanaloa), a telecommunication underground utility scanner (WeCDI), and improvements to Diamond Bakery Manufacturing processes (DBMI).

Despite the challenges of the pandemic, these students adapted extremely well especially when projects required integration with functioning businesses. All teams did a fantastic job planning, designing, problem solving and converting their design concepts into reality. Following the ASME/FRMDC scoring rubric and guidelines, the judges ranked the first and second place teams as follows: First place and \$500 went to Team UHDT, whose UAV will be completing in the 2023 Association for Unmanned Vehicle Systems International (AUVSI) Student Unmanned Aerial Systems (SUAS) Competition. In second place receiving \$300 was Team Kanaloa, whose project now provides the University of Hawaii with its second marine robotics research platform. All of the mechanical engineering student teams demonstrated the application of their cumulative engineering knowledge very well making final scores extremely competitive.

Team Project Descriptions:

First Place Team: Team UHDT: University of Hawaii Drone Technologies

The Team goal was to design and fabricate an autonomous drone capable of completing a waypoint flight path, while avoiding obstacles and delivery of a specified payload to a pre-designated location. Previous drones entered into the Student Unmanned Aerial System Competition were fixed wing vehicles that are fast in flight, but its speed increased its difficulty navigating waypoints and accurately delivering the payload. The customized rotary wing drone resolved many issues and provided a balanced approach to achieve a higher competition score.



Second Place Team: Team Kanaloa: Unmanned marine surface vessel

Team Kanaloa's objective was to recommission an unmanned surface vessel for the purpose of future autonomous marine robotics research. The vessel's re-design features manual differential control and additional sway motion. The team's newly developed electrical system is housed entirely with the twin hulls. Its on-board computer system publishes and records localization sensor data via wireless transmission with a fixed ground station computer.

Team DBMI: Diamond Bakery Manufacturing Innovations

Diamond Bakery needed assistance to optimize their cracker packaging and cookie cooling lines. To improve the cracker line efficiencies, a new chute transition was designed and implemented to reduce breakage and interruptions in the cracker wrapping process. The cookie cooling conveyor was improved with new ramps and enclosed chutes to maintain consistent cookie orientation, which is a prerequisite for future chicaning installation.

Team We Con-du-it

Hawaiian Telcom sponsored the design and development of a working prototype device capable of ultrasonically detecting underground conduits and cables. The device was designed to be portable and with continued development should have the potential to detect and differentiate between cable types.
