To be eligible, projects were required to have been designed or constructed in Hawaii and completed within the last two years. Some of the key judging criteria included: resourcefulness in planning and solving design challenges; contributions to the well-being of people and communities; pioneering use of materials and methods; innovations in construction; minimization of impact on physical environment; and composite application.

RISE, or Residences for Innovative Student Entrepreneurs, is a brand-new integrated livelearn-work-innovation center at the University of Hawaii at Manoa campus. RISE is a unique facility with dormitory-style housing for 374 students, from freshmen to graduate students, and offers housing, workspace, and resources for students interested in entrepreneurship and innovation. The building includes co-working spaces, meeting rooms, and other amenities to support these efforts. RISE includes the construction of a new building and the renovation of the historic, 100-year-old Charles Atherton House which presented numerous challenges due to the age of the building.



Young Brothers was scheduled to offload the island's weekly cargo on the morning of June 19, 2024. Extreme high and low tides were

occurring in Hawaii as a result of the summer solstice. YB personnel determined that it was unsafe to offload the cargo and returned to deeper water. Sea Engineering submitted a proposal for a multibeam bathymetric survey of kaumalapau Harbor the next day. A multibeam bathymetric survey quickly produces a dataset

of high resolution georeferenced soundings. Sea Engineering's equipment was rerouted to Lanai, and quick proposal turnaround and NTP from HDOT resulted in Sea Engineering's response by immediately scheduling the survey.

In this talk Curt will survey the cyber threat landscape, demystify terminology, review attacks and defenses, and highlight best practices for cybersecurity. Curt Dodds is the IT Manager at the Institute for Astronomy at the University of Hawaii, Manoa. Curt started his tech career untraditionally, with a degree in Philosophy from Westmont College. He earned his MS in Software Engineering at Cal State Fullerton. Curt developed software and systems for 15 years in the commercial and defense sectors,

cofounded a tech startup and then pivoted to become IT Director at Simpson University in Redding, CA. In 2015 Curt left California for Hawaii to join the Institute for Astronomy. As a software engineer, Curt uses "Deep Learning" neural networks to solve problems in astronomy, astrophysics, cybersecurity and finance.

2024 BEST SPECIAL PROJECT

Project Name: Lahaina Post-Wildfire Drainline

Project Owner: County of Maui, Department of Public Works, Engineering Division

Submitted by: Brown and Caldwell

On August 8, 2023, wildfires devastated the historic coastal town of Lahaina, Maui County, burning over 2000 acres of residential and commercial areas, resulting in the loss of 102 lives and approximately 2000 structures. Within days of the event, Brown and Caldwell was retained by the County of Maui, Department of Public Works to perform rapid screeninglevel visual assessments of the County storm drainage system within the Lahaina burn zone. This project aimed to document the conditions of the County's storm drain assets and identify those requiring immediate attention to protect the health and safety of the community and the disaster recovery support teams. The secondary purpose of the condition assessment was to identify storm drain damage caused by the fire such that the County could benefit from Federal Aid.

2024 BEST WATER/WASTEWATER/ **ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECT**

Project Name: Waimea Wastewater Treatment Plant R-1 Water Storage and **Distribution System**

Project Owner: County of Kauai, Department of Public Works, Wastewater Management Division

Submitted by: Kennedy/Jenks Consultants. Inc.

The Waimea Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) is located on the southwest side of the Island of Kauai, just outside of Waimea Town. Waimea WWTP serves the areas of Central Waimea Town, Waimea Heights, and Waimea Valley by treating wastewater from domestic, commercial, industrial, and resort development. Design flow of the WWTP is 0.7 MGD and the current average day flow is 0.2 MGD. County of Kauai, Wastewater Management Division and Kennedy Jenks worked together to develop the Waimea WWTP R-1 Distribution System Preliminary Engineering Report that defined a project approach to construct a core storage and distribution system for R-1 recycled water distribution to customers in the area.

Dr. Babcock has been actively involved with ASCE through various leadership positions throughout the years. 


